Deborah Norville is a two-time Emmy© winner and New York Times Best Selling author. She is known to millions as anchor of **Inside Edition**, the nation's top-rated syndicated newsmagazine. Norville is also author of a number of books including the New York Times Best-

Seller, *Thank You Power: Making the SCIENCE of Gratitude Work for YOU*, followed by *The Power of Respect*, detailing the measurable benefits that result from respectful behavior. In 2016, Norville, the longest serving anchor on American television, was inducted into the Broadcasting and Cable Hall of Fame.

Prior to the merger of the Viacom Corporation with CBS, she served as a Director for Viacom Corporation and was a member of the Compensation Committee.
